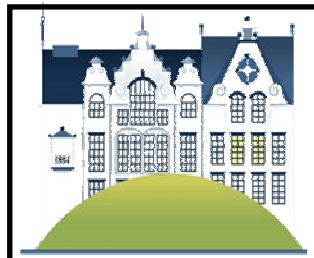

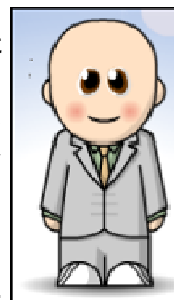

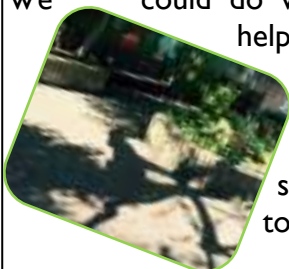
News This Week
