PARENTS AND CHILDREN MATHS MORNING

We are delighted to invite you to a **maths morning next Wednesday 20th May at 9.10am**. This morning will aim to provide an opportunity for you to **join your child in exploring maths activities** and also to give some ideas for maths related **games and activities that can be used at home**. We shall look forward to seeing you!

TRIPS

HOME LEARNING

The **website** has been refreshed with **five new suggestions for Home Learning**. These suggestions relate to this term's topic and include activities about Regent's Park, our surrounding area and plant growth.

It is also useful for children to be working throughout the term on **counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and now also 3's** to support their understanding of number. **Learning to tell the time** is also something that children will revisit throughout the Summer Term.



We will celebrate home learning on Friday afternoons and contributions will be displayed in class. Children have their own Home Learning books which they can use as they wish. Home Learning can also be presented on paper to display in the classroom. Please send in any Home Learning on Friday to be shared.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM



In addition to the home learning on the school website, we will now be using Google Classroom to provide weekly activities and ideas for learning at home that will further the learning that takes place in the classroom. It also offers the opportunity for children to share ideas or answer questions online about a topic provided by their teacher. We will be sending out additional letter to provide more information about Google Classroom and how to log on to it. We look forward to sharing in this new learning experience with you!

SUMMER CONCERT

We are excited to inform you that we will be joining Year 2, Reception and Nursery in creating a summer concert. This will take place at the end of the summer term and we will be notifying you of the date in the very near future so that you can join us in celebrating the musical talents of your children at the end of their school year

PHONICS ASSESSMENTS

This term the children will be assessed on their progress in phonics. A letter was sent out last week inviting you all to come to **an informal meeting** that will explain the process and give you the opportunity to ask any questions. The sessions will take place at **9am and 3pm on Thursday 21**st **May** and will be led Robin and Kate. We look forward to seeing you all there.

READING AT HOME

This term, it is particularly **essential that children continue to read at home**. They will still have the chance to change their books daily, and we would appreciate it if you continue to fill in their home reading records.



Children should be reading every day at home, for at least 10 minutes. They also need to bring their book bags to school daily.

PE AND CLOTHING



Year 1 have PE with Paul Lambert and Mitch every Wednesday afternoon. It is important children wear the correct PE kit for health and safety reasons and children will not be able to take part in sessions without it.

The children will also be doing daily movement and dance with their class teacher. Children should wear comfortable shoes so that they can join in with these sessions daily. <u>Please ensure your child's PE kit is clearly labelled</u>, as it is extremely difficult to get misplaced clothing back to children if it is not. We have found that *iron on labels*, easily ordered on the internet, are the best way to guarantee that you child's clothes do not get misplaced.

Children should **not be wearing jewellery** in school due to Health and Safety reasons. Children **are encouraged though**, **to wear a watch** and may wear a small pair of stud earrings. Any other jewellery worn in school will be removed until the end of the day.
