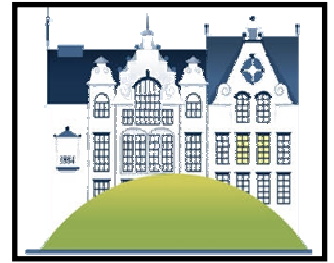

Camden Guidance on Eid

We have received some guidance from Camden regarding Eid this year. Eid is due to fall this year on **either Friday 17th or Saturday 18th July**. This is very close to the end of the school year but the local authority position is clear that only one day should be authorised for Eid, and then only if taken on the official Eid day. All other leave appended to it, or taken under the auspices of an 'Eid day', would be unauthorised. This is of course assuming that Eid does fall on 17th. At this stage it may fall on July 18th. July 18th is a Saturday and if Eid were to fall on this day then pupils would not be entitled to take any day off school as Religious Observation at all.
