I will do the first few to get us up and running, and I will begin with one of my favourite books for younger children. Tyrannosaurus Drip by Julia Donaldson and David Roberts is about a duckbill dinosaur egg which is mistakenly hatched by a fierce, war-loving Tyrannosaurus family. Little



Tyrannosaurus Drip is vegetarian and peaceful and can't keep up with his adopted family. He eventually finds salvation in the arms of a Duckbill tribe where he realises he belongs. The mean Tyrannosauruses try to capture Drip and take him back to their home, only to realise that it might not be as easy as they think... I particularly like reading this book aloud to children, as it has lots of rhyming text which children can join in and remember, plus some great illustrations. I also like the gentle ant war message.
