With <u>Google Drive</u>, the children can continue work they started at school, create new documents, presentations and spreadsheets and share them with their teacher. If you have an iPad at home, Google Drive, Docs, Sheets and Slides can be used by downloading the Google Drive app. <u>Purple Mash</u>, <u>Brain Pop</u> and <u>Espresso</u> are full of a range of interactive learning activities and videos.
