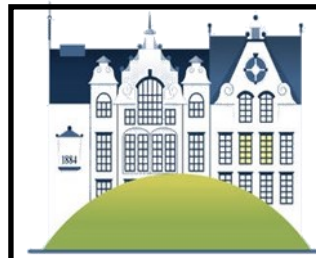

## End of Year Reports

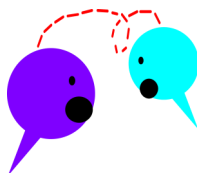
We have started formulating our end of year academic reports for your children and have made a few changes which we think you will like. Reports will go to parents and carers at the beginning of July.
