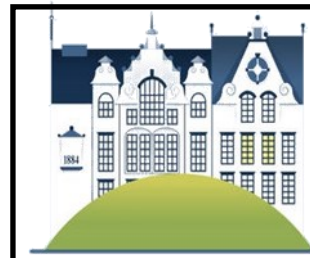

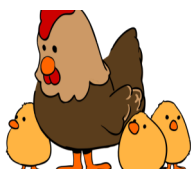
Road Works
