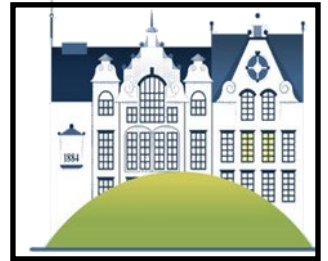

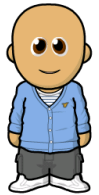

One more week until half term....where has that six weeks gone?! **Robin**



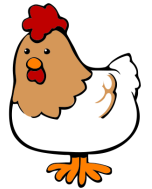
## Staffing

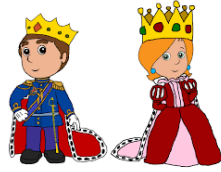

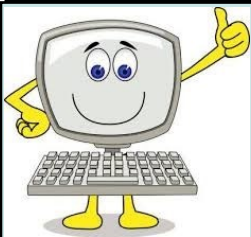
## Class Assemblies
