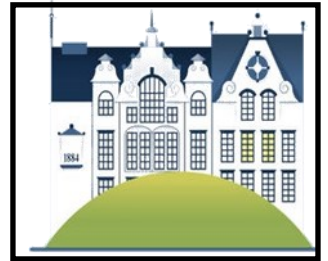

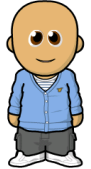

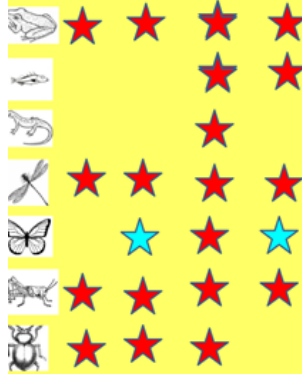


Attendance & Punctuality
