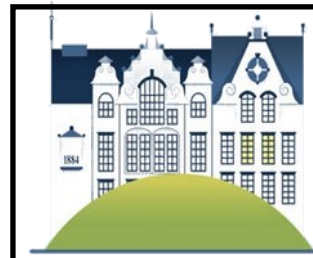

World Religion Day

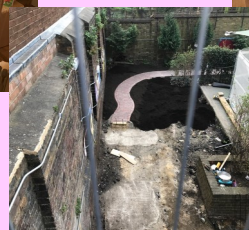

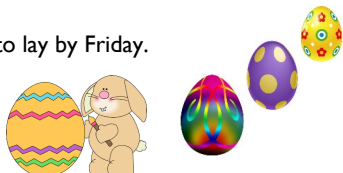
Madonna is going to have intense dance training with Dean and Jordan over the holidays.

The Barge

Things have been going on behind the scenes regarding the barge; it is certainly not forgotten. Most of you will remember this bright idea from 18 months ago and the plan to purchase a canal barge which would become Primrose Hill Primary School's floating classroom. This has proved more complex than originally thought, but after lots of wrangling and discussions with the Canal & River Trust, a mooring was agreed in principle. Now we have to do all sorts of things with surveyors, nautical folk, electrical people and conservationists to tick all the boxes. Therefore we have given ourselves a target of Spring 2018 to have everything complete and in place. The sponsored bounce was the first of many fundraising ideas led by Tania and our new School Business Manager - Irene Mitchell. More info to come next term.
