Nearly all classes had over 96% Attendance and no classes had more than 5 lates. Keep it up everyone!

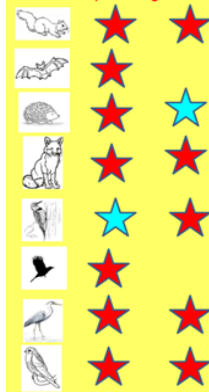
