

Nursery Info

3 and 4 Year Olds for September **Froglets**

We are going to be able to offer our nursery places shortly. This is later than usual due to the new funding arrangements which have caused lots of issues for schools. Offers will be made following the usual criteria - sibling, special circumstances (e.g. ECHP /Looked After child etc.), distance etc. **Then** there will be three eligibility routes:

- 15 hours plus 15 hours funded by the DFE for eligible working parent (s)
- 15 hours plus 15 hours with Camden local 2) offer if you are/were eligible for a two year old place
- 15 hours only but with opportunity to buy a '15 hour bundle top up'. Cost of this to be confirmed.

2 Year Olds – Tadpoles

Building Work

As you know we have grand plans to convert the lower ground floor into a new Reception Learning space and refurb the existing Reception classrooms into YI. Alongside this, the nursery roof, all our windows, electrics

and heating system within the school will be upgraded MAJOR WORKS!!!!

This will need us all to be flexible whilst the work is going on. With this in mind, there are prepatory works in the undercroft, boiler room and plant room beginning in half term. Glad I got that off my chest, its a real dilemma but its such an opportunity. What do you think?


