Diversity Role Model Day

As a primary school, we believe we have a key role society in fighting discrimination in promoting tolerance, diversity and equality. Continuing on this theme, this week we had a workshop from Diversity Role Models. In one class, we welcomed Kevin, a same-sex parent with an adopted son, who read a book about Silo and Roy, two male penguins that adopt a penguin chick; in years 4 & 5, Kevin showed photos of his husband and their adopted son, and invited questions about his family. We felt that the sessions were a great success and that the children demonstrated our values of tolerance and respect for difference, and we have had lots of positive feedback from families too. Some families have also commented that, although the workshops were advertised in the newsletter, they would have liked more notice or advice so that they could prepare thoughtful answers to some of the children's questions, which we will take on board when we have more workshops in the future. We welcome your feedback and would love any ideas for future guests and invite our own parents and families to visit and share their different experiences and identities. Soon the pond/ chicken spa will be finished which we are very excited about, because to be honest Madonna's roller skating lessons are not going too well so she could


do with a soak at the end of the day.
