


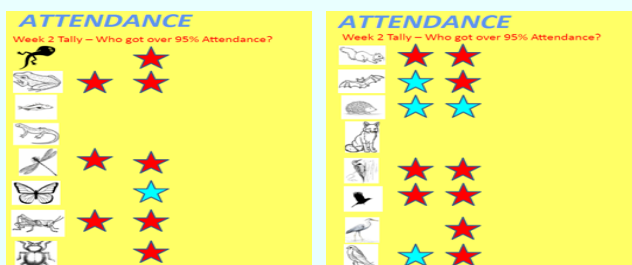


Attendance & Punctuality
