Topic

We shall be studying habitats, interdependence and adaptation and evolution for STEM.

Here are some Home Learning suggestions for your child to do related to topic:

- Create a life timeline to show their own changes over their lifetimes
- Write an autobiography
- Create a time-lapse diary either by doing regular observational drawings from the same view, or taking photos
- Maths we will send home problem solving activities
- there are a range of activities for revising SPaG on the google classroom.
