Stay and Play Maths (Year 1-5)

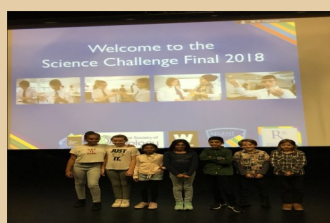
Friday 29th June at the beginning of the school day

Science Challenge

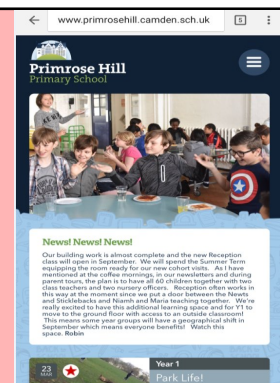
Sophie, Isabel and a few Y5's attended the Camden Science Challenge. Well Done!
