PE kits need to be pre ordered for September. If your child is starting reception this will have been done at stay and play.

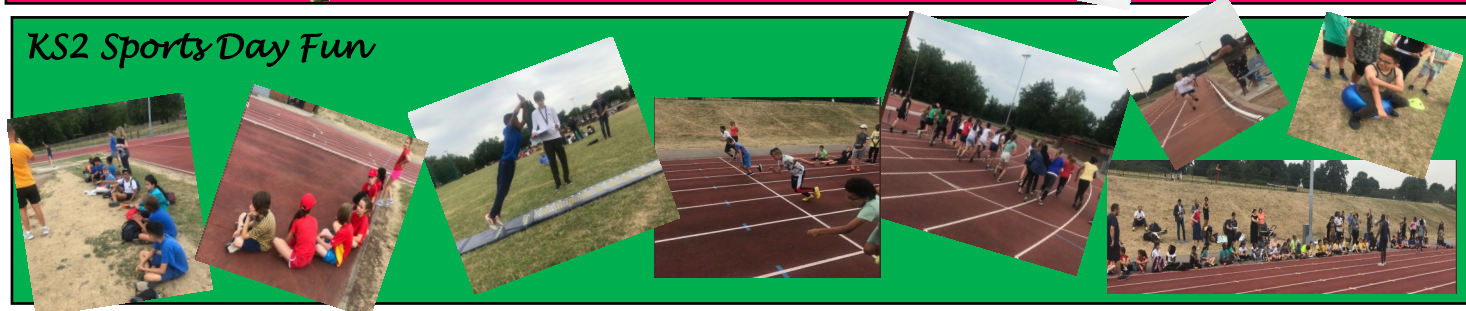
