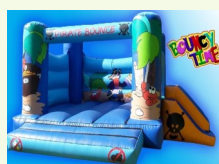

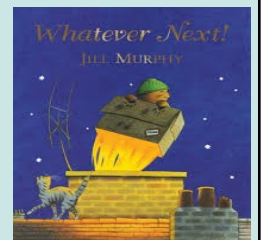
## It's Story Time!

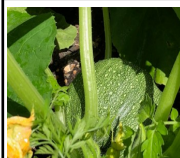
