Absence & Attendance



A big thank you for always being honest when requesting periods of absence from school. Whilst we are able to authorise exceptional circumstances, we will be tightening this this year and 'not authorising' absence during term time. Going on holiday before the end of term or after a term has commenced is always unauthorised and a fixed penalty notice issued. For other avoidable absences, we will be saying no but please discuss these on a case by case basis. Mireille and Lyra have done a great job with promoting attendance amongst families and the children and this will continue so our attendance improves.

Attendance has been very low this week (92.13%). We expect a big change from next week! A few reminders:

- Medical appointments should be arranged OUTSIDE school times.
- Parents should continue to inform us of any absences via our absence line or our email (attendance@primrosehill.camden.sch.uk).
- If we are not informed of absence 5 school days after it occurs, the absence will be marked as 'unauthorised'.
- If you arrive to school between 9:05—9:15am, your child will be marked late.
- Where children arrive after 9.15 am, it will show up on their attendance as missing half a day and will go down as unauthorised late.

We did amazingly last year, but I'm sure we can do better!

Application for Secondary Schools Sept 2020

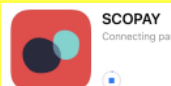
Camden Council co-ordinates the transfer from primary to secondary school for admission to all Camden state secondary schools. Camden are holding an annual Moving On event for primary parents on 19 September 2019 - register for your free place on the Camden website. Finally, please remember to inform us in the office if you have switched your child from school lunch to packed lunch (or vice versa) to avoid any confusion with the kitchen and additional charges.
