HOME LEARNING & GOOGLE CLASSROOM

We will continue to issue home learning on **Fridays**. This will be shared via Google Classroom along with other announcements on how to support your children at home. Paper copies of the home learning are also issued each week. All children will have a home learning book, but they can also share work with us on Google Classroom or on their Google Drive. All home learning should be completed by Thursday. Home Learning is celebrated and acknowledged each week, either through adult marking or through a whole-class sharing session, when children have an opportunity to share work they are particularly proud of.

<u>TOPIC</u>

This half term our topic is **Listen Up.** Within this unit we will explore **Sound** and **The Ear**. We will consider it from a scientific perspective, learning what sound is, how sounds are made and also what affects what we hear. In English we will use words to bring sounds to life, focussing on the sounds of **Aisian cities**.

In PSHE we will delve deeper into the importance of listening, using the book 'The Ear' as a stimulus. It will allow us to think about how emotions are affected by what we hear and who listens to us. Finally we will get stuck into our DT project: **Designing Instruments**.
