Dear Parents & Carers.

Thank you for all your support and patience through our first week of virtual learning - the children, with your guidance, have completed a variety of wonderful learning experiences at home! I hope that you and your children are managing to cope as well as you can during these very uncertain times. I also hope that you are staying healthy and enjoying spending much quality time with each other, despite the unanticipated nature of the position that you now find yourselves in.

Also, a big well done to our entire school community - children, parents and carers, staff at home, staff in school are all being amazing. I feel very heartened by our community spirit.

The whole experience has been a learning curve for our whole community, who are working hard to make Google Classroom a success with your support. We have made some changes and clarified expectations which we hope will further improve your home learning experience.

First of all, please try not to become overwhelmed by the work that has been set or feel under pressure that your child has to complete *everything* that has been provided by their class teacher. What you are now providing at home does not amount to home schooling and we do not expect you to fulfil the roles of class teachers. Your child is simply engaged in 'remote learning' and the hope is that they do the activities provided as it keeps them busy and provides them and you with a daily structure. Furthermore,

- At this stage, all work set by class teachers should be at a level to allow children to *complete it independently* (mainly revision and consolidation of what they already know rather than new learning). Teachers, where applicable, will offer different ways to complete these tasks or offer support if your child doesn't understand the work.
- The expectation is that your child **needs to post at least one English and one Maths activity each day**, but again, if this is difficult or unmanageable, please communicate this with the class teacher or request a phone consultation via the school (0207 722 8500). We welcome posts about other learning, but this is not the expectation.
- Timings of the day will be the same for all children in KS1 and KS2 *if you need to change or adapt timings, please do so,* again communicating this with staff when they call you. We know most parents will be juggling working from home, supporting children and other duties, so please use your judgement with what works for your whole family, though be aware that teachers will mainly be responding on Google Classroom from 9 12noon (*See Daily Plan below.*)
- If children in your *family are sharing a device*, that is fine. Please just make sure they are signing into the the **attendance** register and can do this on one Google Classroom, for example:
 - Good morning Robin, I have to share my device with Syra, so she will sign on after lunch. Can you tell her teacher please? Mireille

All class teachers are in communication with each other and will relay any messages for you.

DO use Google Classroom as a learning tool.	DO NOT use Google Classroom just to socialise with each other unless directed by an adult.
