Some sharpened pencils.

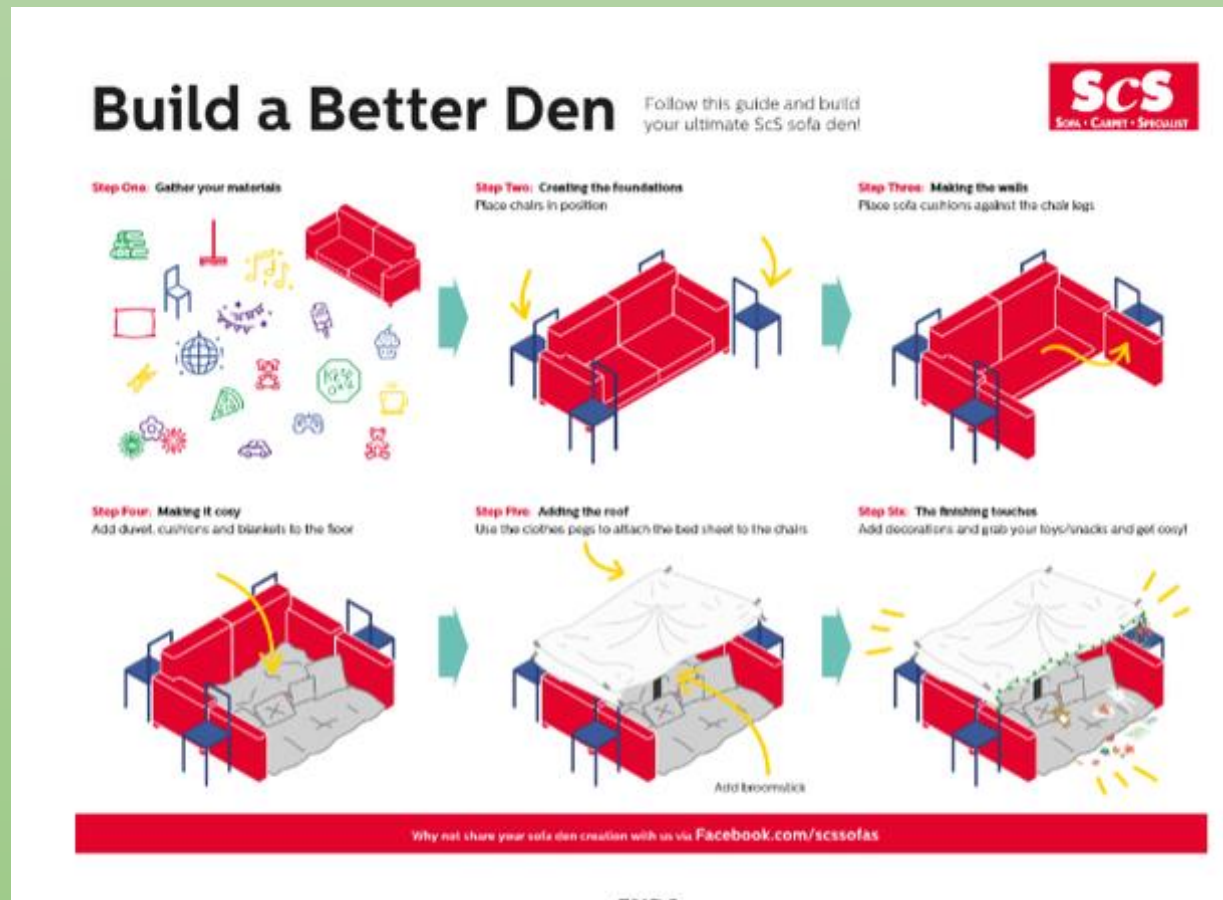
A steady hand and the nerve to keep going.

Make Easter Nests



Ingredients:

200g chocolate

85g cereal (Krispies, cornflakes and shredded wheat all work (shredded wheat looks most like a nest)

Mini eggs (3 per nest)

Cup cake cases.

Method:

Melt the chocolate in a small bowl over a pan of boiling water (Get a parent to help you with this bit) or place it in a bowl in the microwave for 30 seconds on medium

Mix the cereal into the melted chocolate

Put a small amount of mixture in each case and form it into a nest.

Place three eggs in each nest and leave to cool

Become a magazine editor



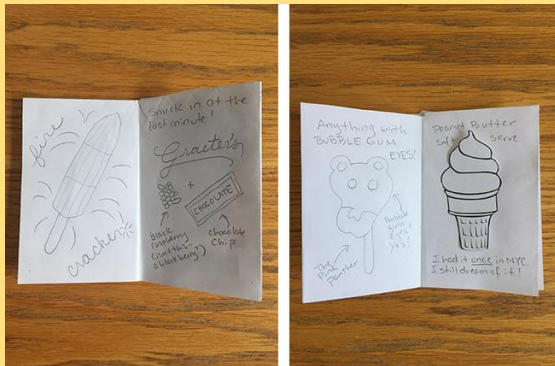
You will need:
