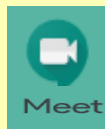

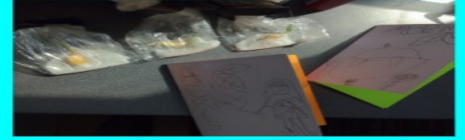
We have also been revisiting subtraction and have had fun playing games like ten pin bowling and Subtraction Lego Race.

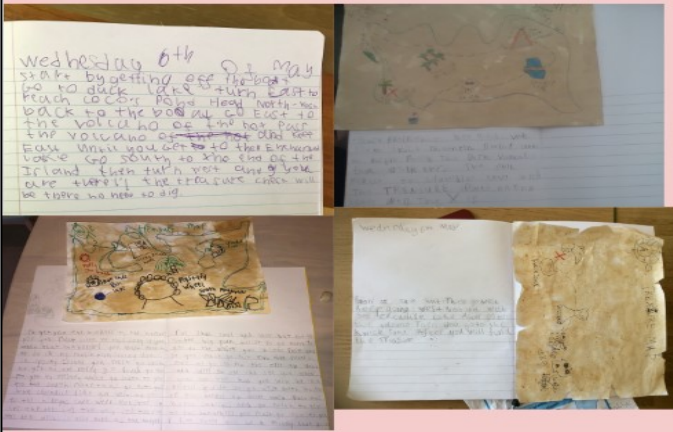

Year 3 & 4

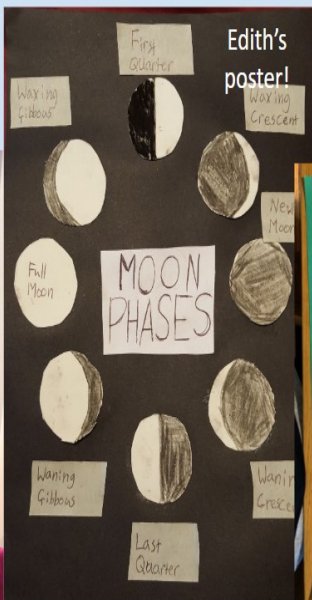
