#### In School Places

Our numbers in school have begun to creep up and we are now at our capacity. The means we have as many children as we can supervise with staff. This means we only have a small amount of personnel available at the moment to come into school.

#### Free School Meals (FSM)

Due to outbreak of the COVID-19, government has decided to issue a voucher of £15 a week to be used on your local supermarket of your choice, for the families who are eligible for FSM

Due to high demand of vouchers being redeemed, Edenred, the company issuing vouchers, has introduced a queuing system, which takes up to an hour to get through.

Having considered this, from next week, 4th May, instead of issuing one voucher of £15 a week, we have arranged to issue one voucher of £30 for two weeks.

Please make sure you redeem your vouchers while they are LIVE as they will expire and we cannot reclaim them.

The Edenred system is open 24 hours, 7 days a week and you can logon anytime. Please be aware that we will NOT be able to remind you to redeem your vouchers that you have received directly from Edenred.










Year 1 have made their own treasure maps with landmarks. They then wrote instructions for how to find the treasure...X marks the spot!
