Weekly Science Activity (this stays the same for the rest of the week) One for outside.....you have been warned Key Vocab: Chemical reaction Bubbles Foams Hydrogen mixed with sodium Plastic Bags Vinegar is an acid Clothes pegs Fizz Explosion Food Colouring 1/3 cup Vinegar (for each bag) 2 Tbsp Baking Soda (for each bag) Pour the vinegar into a baggie and add food colouring to it. Twist the baggie just above the liquid and secure with a clothes peg, leaving a space at the top Add the baking soda to the empty space and seal the bag When you're ready for the fun, remove the clothes peg and allow the baking soda to fall into the vinegar. Watch Book as the bags fill with gas and explode in a fizzing mess! or Dia
