Curriculum Overview:

We will continue to adapt the curriculum this half term and beyond to meet the needs of our learners - whilst ensuring it remains broad and balanced. This half term's focus will be STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Maths) and our topic is *We Are Inventors*.

Below is our Summer 1 Curriculum overview with more information.

PE

Your child's PE session with Jordan & Dean will continue to be every **Tuesday**. Children need to come into school in their PE kits on this day. During these sessions, Jordan & Dean will be social distancing from all children in the class. Teaching Assistants from their class bubble will attend these sessions and will administer any first aid required. All equipment will be suitably sanitised between groups and contact sport will be avoided when possible.

They will also have extra PE sessions **everyday**. They don't need to wear their PE kits for this but should come to school wearing comfortable clothes and trainers.

Music

Music sessions with Tom are being held in the hall to provide extra space for these sessions. As with PE, Tom will be social distancing from all classes and will be supported by the Teaching Assistants from their class bubble. Recorders and other wind instruments will not be used, and all other equipment will be suitably sanitised between groups and suitable music activities chosen.

Home Learning:

Home learning is posted every Friday afternoon on Google Classroom and celebrated in class the following Friday. Everything we set as home learning is reinforcing what we have been covering in school. Doing the home learning means the children get to consolidate their learning and also share with you what they have been doing in class. As well as the Google Classroom work, regular practising of handwriting and phonics/spelling will help your child immensely with their learning.

If you have any issues with devices at home and would like a paper copy of the home learning, please let a member of the Y1 team know.

Reading

We will still have a book corner in our classrooms where the children will be able to select books and read during guided reading sessions, though the shared library will not be in use.

Well done to everyone who is bringing in their book bag every day. It is the expectation now that bookbags come in daily and the children are reading at home every day. Please write in their diary every day when they have read to let us know that it's happening so we can celebrate it in class.

We encourage you to still use Reading Eggs as a reading tool at home too. If you need a copy of your login details, please let us know.

Water & Dressing for school

English teaching and learning will be made up of English sessions, Guided Reading sessions and phonics/spelling sessions. Lessons will be planned in response to the children and adapted to their needs.

We will be practising writing for different purposes (e.g. writing lists, instructions, and letters). Wider Curriculum	<p>Other Topic Areas</p> <p>PSHE In PSHE we will be thinking about friendship, teamwork, and building self-esteem.</p> <p>STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Maths) In STEAM we will start off by learning about materials & their properties. We will use our new knowledge to help us design and build our own inventions!</p> <p>Music This term in Music, Year 1 will continue to play lots of fun music games with a focus on learning to read simple music notation. They will also be playing lots of xylophones!</p> <p>PE Year 1 - In PE this half term we will be focusing on the children's hand eye coordination using a variety of different equipment. The children should furally enjoy PE this term, as we will be introducing the children to new things!</p>
