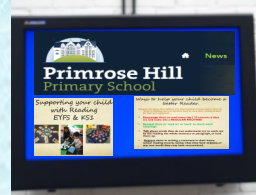

Secondary Places

Camden sent out school offers on March 1st and we hope that you were successful in your application for your chosen school. We know there is plenty of concern if you do not receive your first choice, but try not to worry. Camden provides excellent education across the borough and your parental input into your child's school is crucial in how they and the school perform. If you were offered a place at more than one school, your child will be offered their highest preference school, if a place is available there – all lower preferences will be released.

Your child's name will automatically be placed on a waiting list for any higher preference school(s) than the one offered. You will not go onto a waiting list for your lower choices - if you change your mind about your first choice, then call the school and ask to be put on the waiting list.

At this point, whatever you do... Do not contact the school with any queries as they don't have any details on admission numbers until July. Do contact Camden Admissions if you have any questions on admissions@camden.gov.uk or call 020 7974 1625.
