## Autistic Resourced Provision (ARP)

Phase 1 of the building work is now

complete and we now have the following in use:

- ◆ New children's toilets on the ground floor
- ◆ New ARP Wash Room
- ◆ EYFS & KS1 Classroom on the top floor
- ◆ New adult and ARP wash room on the top floor

To mark a differential between the school and the new facilities, anything in use by the staff and children of the ARP have turquoise coloured doors. The new toilet on the ground floor by the entrance is only to be used by children with adult supervision. The other new toilets are for everyone.

In the next few weeks the dining room annex will be in use once the sound proofing and flooring is complete. Phase 2 works are well underway. This includes starting next week, the children's toilets outside Grasshoppers Classroom. The children in Becca's class will use the toilets on the other side of the hall. I will be publishing an ARP brochure next week to keep you all updated on the many developments.
