Science: Earth and Space: Describe the Moon, Sun and Earth as approximately spherical bodies. Identify the planets in our solar system. Describe the movement of the Earth and other plants relative to the Sun in the solar system. Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth. Explain why we have night and day and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky (using the ideas of the Earth's rotation).
