For the children who are not collected at the station, we will walk back to school together.

Thank you to all the parents who volunteered. We have informed you if you have been chosen from the hat to come with us.


There will be a briefing for all parents who are attending the trip on Monday 4th July in the Community Room at 9am. Sophie K will run through the day and expectations with you. Please come to this briefing whether you have been chosen to come by us or have bought your own ticket.

If you have not been selected, you are welcome to come with us but you will need to purchase your own ticket. Please make sure that you have **pre-bought** your train ticket. You need an **Off-Peak Adult Return** ticket from London St Pancras to Broadstairs, which currently costs £25. We will not have time on the day for adults to buy tickets, so do make sure you have organised this in advance.

If you are coming with us and would like to order an adult fish and chips for £6.50 please let your child's teacher know. This will be charged to your School Money account.

Collection

You should have already informed your teacher if your child is being collected at 4:30pm from St Pancras Station (see map for meeting point) <u>OR</u> from school at 5:15pm. We will only wait until 4.40pm at St Pancras before coming back to school, so make sure you are on time.



Food and Drinks



- Most children have pre-ordered fish and chips. If not, children will need a packed lunch on this day, with water.
- <u>ALL CHILDREN</u> will need some snacks and plenty of water for the journey to and from Broadstairs. It is quite a long day for the children, so please make sure they have enough to keep them going through the day.

We advise that all children bring with them:

- a towel
- sun cream
- a sun hat
- a long sleeved top in case they feel cold/to cover up from the sun
- a plastic bag to keep wet/dirty clothes in
- a spare change of clothes (just in case!)
- a book or small (non-electronic) game to play with on the train (nothing precious or easily lost)
- as we are going in the sea, the children may want to bring or wear swimming costumes or trunks however do be aware that there are not changing rooms on the beach

Please ensure the children do not bring any electronic devices with them. These will be confiscated by the adults and returned when we are back at school.

Sun Cream

We are hoping the weather will be sunny, so you <u>must</u> make sure that you apply long-lasting sun cream on your child before they come to school. Please make sure that your child is confident with reapplying their cream and that they have it with them. We may offer sun cream to children who don't have it with them if the weather is warm. <u>Please let us know if you would not like us to offer sun cream to your child.</u>
