However, pupils in **Nursery (Froglets) and Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6)** is pay for meals unless they have applied for free school meals through the C website and are found to be eligible.


To celebrate the passing of another year at school, we are going to have a little singsong just before home time.

Please join us on **21st July** in the playground **at 1.10pm** if you would like to hear the children's lovely voices sending off the whole school for the summer.




