IMPORTANT: YEAR 6 TRIP UPDATES & OTHER EXCITING EVENTS!

Dear Parents & Carers,

As detailed in our previous letter which was emailed to you, we have the following trips this week. **There have been important changes to the travel to Chessington.**

Thursday 30th June: Lido

Year 6 will spend the day on Hampstead Heath. In the morning we will visit the Lido for which there is a £2.00 entry fee, payable at the door (for which you need to bring £2 cash), **and please follow this link NOW to give consent - as the trip is tomorrow!** <https://forms.gle/kffBwU4LXvbmTThR8> (this link has also been sent by text).

The children may bring up to £5.00 extra on the day to spend in the cafe on ice creams or drinks. The afternoon will be spent on the heath. We will travel by bus and be back at 3:20pm so **a packed lunch is required**. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

Friday 1st July: Chessington

Year 6 will spend the day at Chessington for which there is an **£11.25 entry fee**. The children may bring up to £10.00 extra to spend on the day for photos, souvenirs and a snack. We will go by underground and train and be back at around 17:30, you will be kept updated by texts. **A packed lunch is required**. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, has applied sun cream and has a bottle of water.

Unfortunately TFL have not authorised free travel to Chessington. They are now much more restrictive in their free school travel allowances. **The cost of the travel is an additional £8.60**. Please pay this on SchoolMoney by 9am on Thursday 30th June at the latest. School cannot afford to cover the travel costs and may have to cancel this trip if travel costs are not paid.

4th - 15th July: Year 6 Swimming

Year 6 will go swimming daily except for **Sports Day on the 13th July**. (Some children will miss swimming on 6th July when there is the Camden Transition Day - this is unavoidable.) Swimming is compulsory and part of the P.E. National Curriculum.

Everyday they will need:

- comfortable shoes to walk to Kentish Town Baths in,
- a swimsuit (one piece suits for girls only please - the pool does not allow 2 piece swimwear),
- a swimming cap - this is compulsory for both boys and girls,
- a towel.

Wednesday 13th July: Sports Day

Year 6 will attend Sports Day at Parliament Hill Fields. House colours and appropriate trainers should be worn. Please ensure your child has applied sun cream and has a bottle of water. A packed lunch is required. For more information, please see Jordan's letter.
