










VALUE of the Month: Happiness



New Signing in System



Industrial Action- Wednesday 1st February School Closure

Dear Primrose Hill Families,

As reported in the news and other media outlets, and communicated in the newsletter last week, we have been informed by the NEU teachers trade union that there will be a day of strike action on Wednesday 1st February 2023.

The Chairs of Governors and senior leadership team have assessed the impact of the strike action.

Our two year old provision Tadpoles will be open, but all other classes will be closed to the remaining children in the school.

Teachers will not be providing online work on this day, however your child can access the usual online platforms for independent learning. We will provide details to support this early next week.

Primrose Hill Primary School will open as normal on Thursday 2nd February 2023.

We will further assess the situation for future planned strike dates (Wednesday 2nd, Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March) and will write and share plans prior to these dates.
