- Exciting Childcare Opportunities Available:
- Up to 30 hours per week for 3 & 4-year-olds (if eligible).
- 15 hours of childcare for all 3 & 4-year-olds, regardless of income.
- 15 hours of early learning for eligible 2-year-olds receiving additional government support.

## Key Information:

- The deadline to [apply](#) for your code is **31 March to start from 1 April**.
- Apply as early as possible and confirm eligibility every 3 months via [GOV.UK](#).
- From September 2025, eligible working parents can access up to 30 hours of childcare per week from the term after their child turns 9 months old.

# Help with childcare costs at Camden

All parents can get some help with the cost of childcare. The amount of help you get will depend on:

- your child's age
- if you are working
- if you are receiving certain benefits
- if your child has a disability

## When your child is 2

If you are a low income or a working family, you may be able to get up to 15 hours of free childcare for your 2 year old.

If you are eligible, you can apply once your child is 18 months old.

## When your child is 3 and 4

All 3 and 4-year-olds can get 15 hours of free childcare during term time. This starts from the term after their third birthday.

There is no need to apply for this, just talk to the childcare provider.

If you are working

Working parents can get an extra 15 hours of free childcare from the Government. If you have a partner, you must both be working.

If you are working and your child is 3 or 4, [apply on the childcare choices website](#).

If you are not working

If you live in Camden, you can apply for 30 hours of early education and childcare through the Camden Enhanced Offer.

You can apply 3 months before your child's third birthday
